If you retired at the end of the school year your Mason Tenders Welfare Fund insurance premium is due by September 1, 2017.

Please mail in your payment for \$300 for the year if you retired at age 65 or \$600 for the year if you retired before your 65th birthday. Include in the memo section of your check the notation (**September, 2017 to August, 2018**). We suggest mailing your check by August 1st. Mail your check to:

Please also remember, and hopefully, none of us will need this benefit for many decades to come that if you are enrolled in the Mason Tender Health Plan you have a death benefit.
